ELITCH THEATRE FOUNDATION

David served as Vice President of The Historic Elitch Theatre Foundation 2014-16 after serving as a board member from 2010-2014. The Foundation's purpose is to renovate and revitalize the Elitch Theatre, built in 1891 and was one of the first summer stock theaters in the US. Construction on the interior of the building began in July 2013 and Phase 2 was completed in October, 2013. He was also Chairman of the Elitch Theatre Summer Film Series Committee which, as a fundraiser for the Foundation, raised \$10,000 in sponsorship for new projection equipment. The Film Series brought in up to \$15,000 a year from 2012 to 2016 in donations toward the renovation costs of the theatre. Along with Gavin Mayer, David was Co-Chairman of the Elitch Theatre New Works Festival 2015/16. This festival brought readings and workshops of Actor's Equity sanctioned new works to the stage of the Elitch Theatre, the first live, professional theatre performances on that stage since 1991. He also managed Doors Open Denver events in 2012, 2014 and 2015. This event opened the doors of the theatre to the public. David was the Programming Coordinator for all of these events which were the first performances in decades at Elitch's.
